

### Grading Scale/Promotion

Each year, students in grades 9-11 should earn a minimum of 7 credits in order to be classified at the next grade level. Students may earn more than 7 credits per year but cannot earn more than 8 credits.

Students must pass English each year before being allowed to take the next level of English. In addition, Algebra I is a prerequisite for Algebra II, and these two courses and geometry are prerequisites for pre-calculus. \*Academic requirements and credits to graduate may be modified by the office of the Principal in accordance to the Alabama Course of Study.
